# **Texas Juvenile Justice Department State Financial Assistance Contract 2016 - 2017 Biennium**

## **Amendment Number Eight**

This is Amendment Number Eight to the State Financial Assistance Contract for the 2016 – 2017 Biennium between the State of Texas, represented by and through the Texas Juvenile Justice Department, hereinafter called "the Department", and the juvenile board of CAMERON County hereinafter called the "Grantee". In consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Department and the Grantee, for the consideration hereinafter detailed, make the following amendment.

### **Article I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF AMENDMENT**

The purpose of Amendment Number Eight is to delineate the duties of the Department and the Grantee regarding the distribution, receipt and expenditure of grant funding to provide assistance to the Grantee for the Supplemental & Emergent Needs Fund – Round Three (FY2016) which provides resources to local juvenile probation departments for an array of programs, services, placements, other operating costs, and capital purchases. All provisions in the 2016 - 2017 Biennium State Financial Assistance Contract and any fully executed amendments thereto that do not conflict with the provisions of Amendment Number Five remain in full force and effect.

### **Article II. Amendments to Article II INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS AND DOCUMENT INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE**

Article II, Section 2.1, Subsection 2.1.1 is amended by adding Paragraph 2.1.1.10 to read as follows:

2.1.1.10 Exhibit J. *Supplemental & Emergent Needs Fund – Round Three (FY2016) (Amendment Eight).*

### **Article III. Amendments to Article IV OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT SUPPLEMENTAL & EMERGENT NEEDS FUND – ROUND THREE (FY2016)**

Article IV, Section 4.1 is amended by adding Subsection 4.1.5 to read:

- 4.1.2 **Supplemental & Emergent Needs Fund – Round Three (FY2016) Funds.** To the extent funds are available, the Department shall allocate a one-time distribution of funds in an amount not to exceed ~~\$4,000,000.00~~ payable to the Grantee for the approved purposes:  
**SUMMER PROGRAM (2400); DETENTION CONTROL PANEL ETC (40395)**  
as outlined in the Grantee's *Request for Funding: Supplemental and Emergent Needs* form and approval notification. These funds are distributed as a supplement to funding which may have been previously allocated by the Department under this grant.

*For the faithful performance of the terms of this Contract, the parties hereto in their capacities as stated, execute this Contract, affix their signatures and bind themselves.*
