



**TEXAS JUVENILE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT  
RESEARCH OR STATISTICAL PROJECT AGREEMENT  
AMENDMENT 1 to CONTRACT CON0001427**

The **Texas Juvenile Justice Department**, hereinafter the “**Department**”, and **AMikids, Inc.**, hereinafter the “**Requester**”, acknowledge that they have previously entered into an Agreement fully executed on **August 8, 2022**, for the disclosure of certain confidential juvenile justice information collected and maintained for statistical and research purposes by the Department. This contract is identified as **Contract CON0001427**.

Both parties represent and warrant that the individual signing this Amendment is authorized to sign this document on behalf of their party and to bind their party under this Amendment, and that the terms herein are expressly made part of the Agreement.

The parties hereto agree to be bound by the terms of the existing Agreement, including prior amendments, if any, subject to the following changes permitted pursuant to **SECTION XI, GENERAL**. Pursuant to **SECTION XI, GENERAL**, the contract is amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 2 of the contract is deleted and replaced with the following:

“WHEREAS, the Requester has submitted a written request research or statistical project proposal to the Department dated January 12, 2022, for the project entitled “*AMikids Outputs and Outcomes Evaluation - Texas*”, attached hereto and incorporated by reference as **Attachment 1**; and”

2. Section III of the contract is deleted and replaced with the following:

“The Department will provide the Requester the following: Data for the specific indicators referenced in **Attachment 1** for youth who completed AMikids Rio Grande Valley Program during calendar years 2020 and 2021 (completion status, as deemed by TJJD). These data will be presented in the aggregate by program in Requester’s annual report. No individual-level data will be reported in any form. The data released by the Department will be for each youth, but will not include identifying information or any numbers which would allow for the determination of the identity of any of the youth (i.e., no TJJD, AMikids, PID, TRN, or SID numbers etc.). The Department may choose to label each youth’s data with a pseudo-identifier that cannot be used to identify the youth through comparison with any other dataset, or may provide identifiable data, or may provide aggregate data. The data provided will allow the calculation of the indicators referenced in **Attachment 1**. The request includes two annual releases of data. The Department will provide the Requester with the first release of data for the calendar year 2020 cohort in 2022 and the second release of data for the calendar year 2021 cohort in 2023.”
