THAT THE TEXAS YOUTH COMMISSION on behalf of the STATE OF TEXAS by and through Dwight Harris, Executive Director of the Texas Youth Commission, as "GRANTOR" for and in consideration of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1) and other goods and valuable consideration, including any necessary repairs resulting from installing, constructing, inspecting, repairing, maintaining and reconstructing utility improvements, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, paid by the CITY OF EDINBURG, TEXAS, a home-rule Municipal Corporation of Hidalgo County, Texas, ("GRANTEE"), and the further consideration of the benefits to be derived by Grantor from the placing of water mains, sanitary sewer mains, storm sewer mains and public utilities on the premises hereinafter described and the necessary repairs thereto, do by these presents DEDICATE, GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and CONVEY subject to the existing easements unto the said CITY OF EDINBURG, Hidalgo County, Texas fifteen-feet (15') of the property as a utility easement for the purpose of installing, constructing, inspecting, repairing, maintaining and reconstructing utility improvements together with all incidental improvements, in, under, over, upon, along and across the following described tract of land and premises, to wit:

A 0.591 acre tract of land out of that portion of the Texas Youth Commission Subdivision, and as per map or plat thereof recorded in Volume 24, Page 121, Map Records, of Hidalgo County, Texas;

Said 0.591 acre tract of land is more particularly described by metes and bounds and map attached hereto as Exhibits, "A" and "B" for all purposes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD subject to existing easements the same perpetually to the City of Edinburg, its successors and assigns, together with the right and privilege at any and all time to enter said premises, or any part thereof, for the purpose of installing, constructing, inspecting, repairing, maintaining and reconstructing utility improvements



BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE WEST LINE OF TEXAS YOUTH COMMISSION SUBDIVISION, SOUTH 08 DEGREES 39 MINUTES 49 SECONDS WEST, 2572.01 FEET FROM IT'S NORTHWEST CORNER, FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER HEREOF;

THENCE, SOUTH 81 DEGREES 09 MINUTES 11 SECONDS EAST, 40.0 FEET TO A POINT, FOR THE MOST WESTERLY NORTHEAST CORNER HEREOF;

THENCE, SOUTH 8 DEGREES 38 MINUTES 49 SECONDS WEST, 34.45 FEET TO A POINT, FOR AN INTERIOR CORNER HEREOF; SAID POINT BEING ON A CURVE TO THE LEFT;

THENCE, PARALLEL TO THE PROPOSED NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY OF MONTE CRISTO ROAD (F.M. 1925), IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION, WITH SAID CURVE TO THE LEFT, ON A RADIUS OF 22,853 FEET, THRU AN ARC OF 01 DEGREES 08 MINUTES 14 SECONDS AND A DISTANCE OF 453.61 FT. THENCE, CONTINUE PARALLEL TO THE PROPOSED NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF MONTE CRISTO ROAD (F.M. 1925), IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION; WITH A CURVE TO THE RIGHT, ON A RADIUS OF 22,983 FT., THRU AN ARC OF 02 DEGREES 49 MINUTES 21 SECONDS AND A DISTANCE OF 1132.23 FEET, (CHORD BEARING SOUTH 81 DEGREES 54 MINUTES 34 SECONDS EAST 1132.12 FEET) TO A POINT ON THE EAST LINE OF TEXAS YOUTH COMMISSION SUBDIVISION, FOR THE MOST EASTERLY NORTHEAST CORNER HEREOF;

THENCE, WITH THE EAST LINE OF TEXAS YOUTH COMMISSION SUBDIVISION, SOUTH 08 DEGREES 38 MINUTES 49 SECONDS WEST, 15.07 FEET TO A POINT ON THE PROPOSED NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF MONTE CRISTO ROAD (F.M. 1925), FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER HEREOF; SAID POINT BEING ON A CURVE TO THE LEFT;

THENCE, IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION; WITH THE PROPOSED NORTH LINE OF MONTE CRISTO ROAD (F.M. 1925), WITH SAID CURVE TO THE LEFT ON A RADIUS OF 22,968 FEET, THRU AN ARC OF 02 DEGREES 49 MINUTES 23 SECONDS AND A DISTANCE OF 1131.67 FEET (CHORD BEARING NORTH 81 DEGREES 58 MINUTES 35 SECONDS WEST, 1131.80 FEET), TO A POINT OF REVERSE CURVE;
